A winning way to cap it all off

THE tradition of popping a cork from a champagne bottle and chucking it out is over.

Hackney-based firm Zork has developed a resealable sparkling wine closure which, it says, benefits producers, consumers and the environment.

Zork's SPK closure, which has been given a gold innovation award by the Packaging Council of Australia, is a fully recyclable alternative to the traditional cork and muselet - the wire cage which holds the cork in place.

Zork co-founder and technical director John Brooks said SPK had a 40 per cent lower carbon footprint than cork and muselet and featured a foil and gas barrier which prevented flatness and oxidation when the bottle was resealed.

"What we have done with the SPK closure is focus really heavily on having a benefit for every step of the supply chain, from winemaker to consumer," he said.

The SPK has a soft seal which holds the pressure, a foil gas barrier to prevent flatness and oxidation and a collet and cap locking

mechanism. Mr Brooks said the SPK closure was competitively priced and provided a unique selling point.

Commercial production of SPK is scheduled to begin next month.

Founded in 2003 to develop innovative

closures for the global wine market, Zork created its first product, the STL closure, for still wines.

Mr Brooks said the STL enjoyed success internationally, but its domestic impact was hampered by the introduction of screw caps.

VEHICLE SAFETY RECALL - R0906, R090D and PG9AC.

Nissan Motor Co. (Australia) Pty Ltd is recalling the Nissan X-TRAIL and DUALIS vehicles listed below for rectification of the following condition:

Description of Problem

A concern has been detected relating to the cover screw securing the pinion shaft of the steering gear to the gear housing which may loosen and cause noisy steering operation. In the worst case scenario the cover screw may eventually come out which would result in a loss of steering control. At this stage, there are no reported cases of this incident in Australia.

Recommended Action

Owners of affected vehicles have been notified by mail at their last known address. Owners should contact any Nissan Dealer, to arrange for inspection and rectification of their vehicle. The rectification will consist of inspection of the steering gear to confirm if the cover screw is loose. If loose, the cover screw will be retightened and all affected vehicles will have a lock plate installed to prevent any reoccurrence. Any required work will be performed free of charge to you.
